## PERFORMANCE TIPS

- Use a minimum of 10 gal./ac. water volume to get good coverage on the crop

## ACTIVE INGREDIENTS

- Group 3 (prothioconazole)
- Group 11 (azoxystrobin)

## RAINFAST

- Avoid application if heavy rainfall is imminent

## TREATMENT AREA

- One case (2 x 10 L) treats 60 acres
- One drum (108 L) treats 325 acres at 337 mL/ac. (consult label for more information)

## CROP STAGING

- Lentils: apply at beginning of flowering or at first sign of disease
- Canola: apply between 10% and 50% bloom
- Read label for all other crop staging guidelines
