Tanker/Vehicle Accident		Switch off engine and electrical equipment. Keep people away, warn other traffic. Check for spills, leaks. Call the emergency services: Dial 111								
Spill or leak	produc collect	Wear PVC overalls, chemical resistant gloves, respirator and safety goggles. Prevent further spillage. Absorb spilled product and place in sealable container for disposal. Wash down affected area with water plus detergent. Absorb and collect washings and place in the same sealable container for disposal. Seek advice from the local authority regarding disposal.
