EMERGENCY PROCEDURES

IF THIS HAPPENS	DO THIS
Tanker/Vehicle Accident	Switch off engine and electrical equipment. Keep people away, warn other traffic. Check for spills, leaks. Call the emergency services: Dial 111
Spill or leak	Evacuate spill area. Wear overalls, chemical resistant gloves, footwear, and full-face mask with organic vapour and particulate matter canister. Prevent further spillage. Prevent spillage from entering drains and waterways. If possible salvage uncontaminated product. Place spilled material in sealable container for disposal. Wash down affected area with water plus liquid chlorine bleach. Absorb and collect washings and place in same sealable container as spilled material. Seek advice from the Local Authority regarding disposal. For all major spills inform the Fire Service immediately followed by local Health Protection Officers. In the event of an uncontrolled spillage, alert the Local Authority or Regional Council at the earliest opportunity.
Fire	Call the Fire Service: Dial 111. Wear PVC protective clothing and self-contained breathing apparatus. During a fire toxic fumes may be released. Extinguish fires with water fog, foam or carbon dioxide. Contain run-off. Keep non-involved persons away.

FIRST AID

If Swallowed:	Do NOT induce vomiting. For advice contact the National Poisons Centre 0800 POISON (0800 764 766) or a doctor immediately.
If in Eyes:	Hold eyelids apart and flush the eye continuously with running water for at least 15 minutes. Contact the National Poisons Centre or a doctor immediately.
If on Skin:	If skin or hair contact occurs, remove contaminated clothing and flush skin and hair with running water. Do not scrub the skin. Contact the National Poisons Centre or a doctor immediately.
If Inhaled:	Remove patient to fresh air. If not breathing, give artificial respiration, preferably mouth-to-nose. Contact the National Poisons Centre or a doctor immediately.

STORAGE AND SEGREGATION SUMMARY

Storage: Store under lock and key, away from children and unauthorised persons. Store in original container, tightly closed, in a cool, dry, well-ventilated area out of direct sunlight. Do NOT store near food, feedstuffs, animals, or fertilisers.

Aggregate Storage Volume Thresholds: When stored with substances of the same hazard the aggregate quantity must be considered. For full details refer to the current NZS8409 Management of Agrichemicals and the HSNO Regulations.
