## Planned rate range

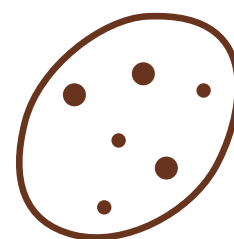
20–25 g/100m of row + At a row spacing of 0.85m this equates to 2.35–2.85kg/ha

## Application timing

Apply at planting into the open furrow as seed piece is placed into furrow

## Compatibility

Amishield is compatible with azoxystrobin, metalaxyl, fipronil, imidacloprid and iprodione



## Benefits of Amishield

- **Amishield** has no movement out of the treated protection zone, this may mean some infection is likely to occur.

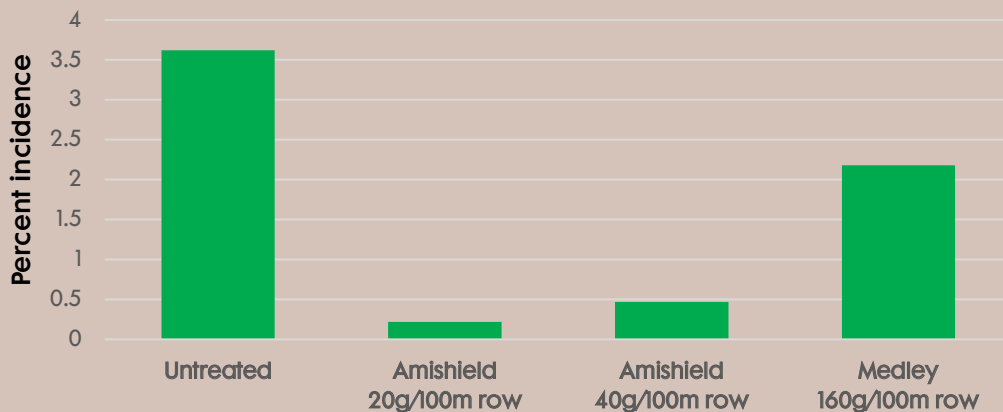
## Flexible use rate – suggested fit

- 20g/100m row for powdery scab (PS)
- 20g/100m row for powdery scab and low pressure pink rot
- 25g/100m row for powdery scab and high pressure pink rot

# Pink rot management

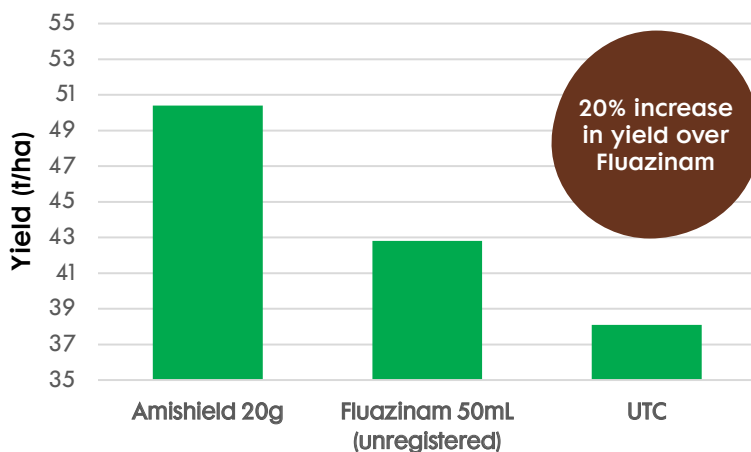
Light to moderate pressure
