



Authorisation update – TAZER (azoxystrobin)

Tazer (MAPP 15495) will soon be authorised for use on an extended range of crops, including potatoes.

- ✓ Label extension of current authorisation – no new MAPP number will be issued.
- ✓ Existing stocks of Tazer bearing the above MAPP number may be applied in line with the newly added authorised uses provided a copy of the updated label text is made available to be read by operators prior mixing/spraying and conditions of application are met in full.
