New Sown Ley (< 1 yr. old)

Established (> 1 yr. old)

Sward for Destruction

Kyleo 5.0 l/ha

Plough and reseed grass after 7 days or clover after 14 days.

Direct drill after 1 month

No Clover

April - Aug
PastureMaster 2.5 l/ha
 + **Tomahawk 2** 0.75 l/ha

Sept - Oct
CloverMaster 2.5 l/ha
 + **Tomahawk 2** 0.75 l/ha

Clover

Feb - Oct 15th
CloverMaster 2.5 l/ha
 + **Squire Ultra** 30 g/ha

Application after June can only be made to re-sowing of permanent grassland PG01

Knapsack

Thrust 90ml in 10 litres water for Docks, Nettle, Ragwort, Thistles

Weeds must be actively growing at application.

Water volume = 200 l/ha

Grazing interval = 2 weeks

Cutting interval = 3 weeks

Ragwort - animals should be excluded from treated areas until any ragwort has completely recovered or died and there is no visible sign of the dead weed.
