



CONTROL OF VOLUNTEER POTATOES WITH KYLEO

Following the difficult lifting conditions last autumn the problem of groundkeepers in following crops is likely to be even more severe than normal. Kyleo has been shown to be more effective than ordinary glyphosate and users should follow the advice below to achieve the best results

- Ensure plentiful leaf is present & apply in good growing conditions
- Control of volunteer potatoes can be variable, even with Kyleo due to variation in maturity
- Early and second early varieties are controlled well with 5.0 l/ha Kyleo. These varieties normally grow quickly and have a sufficient leaf surface at spraying time.
- Maincrop and especially late maturing potato tubers often grow more slowly and groundkeepers only develop one or two leaves which is not sufficient for effective treatment. It is important to have enough leaf surface at the treatment time to ensure enough A.I. enter the plants to kill the tubers
- For these varieties we have found that 3.0 L of Kyleo + 3.0 L/ha Clinic Up is the best treatment.



Good emergence & growing conditions = good results

Lack of emergence & poor growing conditions likely to lead to poor control.
