## USE SUMMARY

### RATES

**Wheat and barley:** Apply 0.4 to 1 ounce per acre after the crop is in the 2-leaf stage, but before the flag leaf is visible.

Do not exceed 1 ounce per acre per crop season.

**Fallow:** Apply 0.4 to 1 ounce per acre to fallow in the spring, summer or fall when the majority of weeds have emerged and are actively growing.

Do not exceed 1 ounce per acre per crop season. Rapport® BroadSpec should be applied in combination with other suitable registered fallow herbicides such as glyphosate plus 2,4-D (ester formulations work best) or glyphosate plus dicamba. When applied at a rate of 0.4 to 0.6 ounce per acre, Rapport BroadSpec must be used in a tank-mix combination with other registered fallow herbicides.

**Preplant burndown:** Apply 0.4 to 1 ounce per acre as a burndown treatment prior to, or shortly after planting (prior to emergence). The total amount cannot exceed 1 ounce per acre per crop season.

Apply up to 0.6 ounce per acre of Rapport BroadSpec as a pre-plant burndown to cotton. Allow at least 14 days from time of application to time of planting cotton.

**Post harvest:** Apply 0.4 to 1 ounce per acre to crop stubble after harvest. Use the 1 ounce per acre rate when weed infestation is heavy and consists mainly of those weeds listed under the "WEEDS PARTIALLY CONTROLLED" section of the label or when application timing and environmental conditions are marginal. Apply Rapport BroadSpec when all or most of the weeds have germinated.

Annual broadleaf weeds should be past the cotyledon stage, actively growing and less than 4" tall or wide. Rainfall immediately after treatment can wash Rapport BroadSpec off of weed foliage, resulting in reduced weed control. Several hours of dry weather are needed to allow Rapport BroadSpec to be sufficiently absorbed by weed foliage.
