USE SUMMARY

AQUATIC SITES

WEEDS AND BRUSH ON BANKS OF NON-IRRIGATION CANALS AND DITCHES: 44 to 88 oz/A for annual weeds. 88 oz/A for biennial, perennial and susceptible woody plants.

EMERGENT AND FLOATING WEEDS (HYACINTH, ALLIGATORWEED): 88 to 175 oz/A.

SUBMERGED WEEDS: Up to 3.88 gals/A ft.

TERRESTRIAL SITES

PASTURE AND RANGELAND: Maximum of 2.75 pts/A for annual and biennial weeds. Maximum of 5.5 pts/A on perennial and woody species.

ROADSIDES/ROWS/FENCEROWS: 2.5 to 3.5 pts/A.
