USE SUMMARY

Apply to actively growing weeds. Extreme conditions such as drought or near freezing temperatures before and following application may reduce weed control and increase the risk of crop injury. Only weeds that have emerged at application will be affected.

Garden beet, canola (rapeseed), crambe	1/4 to 1/2	1/2
Mint (spearmint and peppermint)*	1/3 to 2/3	1
Permanent grasses on CRP land, non-cropland, non-legu- minous trees, rangeland and permanent grass pastures	1/3 to 1-1/3	1-1/3
Spinach	1/6 to 1/3	1/2
Stone fruits, popcorn, sweet corn	1/3 to 2/3	2/3
Turnip	1/3 to 1/2	1/2
