USE SUMMARY

Activate with at least 0.5 inches of rainfall, irrigation or shallow incorporation (1-2 inches) for optimum performance.

DO NOT apply aerially or through any type of irrigation system.

DO NOT apply with dry fertilizers or other granular products.

Apply to soil free of clods, weeds, and debris such as leaves and mulch for best results.
