## USE SUMMARY

### RATES

**Annual weeds:** Apply to actively growing annual grasses and broadleaf weeds. For broadcast applications, use 1.5 pt of Foresters'<sup>®</sup> per acre plus 2 or more quarts of a nonionic surfactant per 100 gallons of spray solution if weeds are less than 6 inches tall. If weeds are more than 6 inches tall, use 2½ pints per acre plus 2 or more quarts of an approved nonionic surfactant per 100 gallons of spray solution.

For hand-held, high-volume applications, use a .75 percent solution of this product in water plus 2 or more quarts of a nonionic surfactant per 100 gallons of spray solution and apply to foliage of vegetation to be controlled.

**Perennial weeds:** Apply to actively growing weeds. Apply 4.5 to 7.5 pints per acre as a broadcast spray or as a .75 to 1.5 percent solution with hand-held equipment.

**Woody brush and trees:** Apply to actively growing trees and shrubs. Apply 3 to 7.5 pints per acre as a broadcast spray or as a .75 to 1.0 percent solution with hand-held equipment.
