USE SUMMARY

Crop varieties vary in response to 2,4-D and some are easily injured. Apply this product only to varieties known to be tolerant to 2,4-D. If you are uncertain concerning tolerant varieties or local use situations that may affect crop tolerance to 2,4-D consult your seed company, state Agricultural Extension Service or qualified crop consultant for advice.

ORCHARD FLOOR (APPLES, PEARS, STONE FRUIT, NUT ORCHARDS):

Annual and biennial broadleaf weeds: 1-2 pints/A

Perennial broadleaf weeds: 4 pints/A

Directions for Use: For application to orchard floors, use coarse, low-pressure sprays and sufficient water for thorough coverage of weeds. Apply to annual weeds when small and actively growing. Apply to perennial weeds from bud to bloom stage. Because newly established trees or young orchards are more susceptible to 2,4-D injury, apply only to orchards that are at least one year old and well-established as indicated by vigorous plant growth.

Preharvest Intervals:

Apple and Pear: Do not harvest within 14 days of application.

Stone Fruit: Do not harvest within 40 days of application.

Nut Orchard and Pistachio: Do not harvest within 60 days of application.

Application Restrictions:

Do not allow spray to drift onto or contact foliage, fruit, stems, trunks of trees or exposed roots as injury may result.

Do not apply to newly established or young orchards. Trees must be at least one year old and in vigorous condition.

Do not apply during bloom.

Do not apply to bare ground as injury may occur.

Do not graze or feed cover crops from treated orchards.

FILBERTS (ORCHARD FLOOR)

Annual broadleaf weeds: 2.1 pints per 100 gal spray solution per acre

Application Restrictions:

Do not apply to bare ground as injury may result.

Do not use on light sandy soil.

Use restrictions as listed in orchard floor section above also apply.

GRAPE VINEYARD*

Apply when weeds are in the bud to early bloom stage and growing vigorously.

Apply after shatter following bloom and before grape shoots reach the ground or during dormant season.

Apply at 1.8-2.7 pints per acre.

Directions for use: Dilute in 10 to 100 gals of water to treat one acre of ground to be sprayed. For band or spot treatment, calculate rates according to the actual portion of acre treated. Use a hooded boom and low pressure flooding nozzles to deliver coarse droplets.

Preharvest Intervals:

Do not harvest within 100 days of application.

Precaution: Grapes are extremely sensitive to 2,4-D. Use a direct application so no 2,4-D contacts grape leaves and young shoots or stems.
