1 SCOUTING IS NECESSARY

To effectively control fall weeds we must know some things about them. As with any herbicide application, weed species, size and density are all important factors of selecting herbicides and rates.

2 CONSIDER YOUR MODES OF ACTION

Choosing multiple modes of action for fall weed management can slow herbicide resistance. Consider rotating to alternative modes of action that differ from the past growing season.

3 THE BENEFIT OF RESIDUAL HERBICIDES

One of the most effective resistance management tools include residual herbicides. Incorporating residual herbicides with your fall burndown application can spread the workload and buy time should spring application window be compressed.

Also remember that once soils reach a specified temperature, residual herbicides become 'dormant' and are stored. This means that when soil temperature rise and weed seed begins germinating again, adequate herbicide is already in the soil ready to act on these weeds.
