### USE SUMMARY

Apply to young, actively growing weeds as a post-emergence broadcast or spot spray. Use only medium or coarser spray nozzles to minimize drift and do not apply at wind speeds over 10 mph or during temperature inversions

**BAHIAGRASS, BLUEGRASS, COMMON BERMUDAGRASS, FESCUE, RYEGRASS AND ZOYSIAGRASS**

**Use rate:** 3 to 4 pts/A

**Spray volume:** 3 gal/A to 220 gal/A

Some hybrid bermudagrass may be sensitive to this product. Use reduced rates if grass is stressed from heat or drought. Higher water volumes may be used when tank-mixed with a turf fertilizer. Follow fertilizer labels.

**BENTGRASS**

**Use rate:** 1.8 pt/A

**Spray volume:** 145 gal/A

Apply on closely mowed bentgrass, preferably in May or mid-August through September. Slight turf yellowing will disappear after about one week.
