

FAIRWAY SPRAY PROGRAM

CONTROLLING TOUGH TURF DISEASES FOR FAIRWAYS + GREENS & TEES

EARLY-SEASON DOLLAR SPOT CONTROL

This is the most important dollar spot spray of the season. By applying early, the primary inoculum level of the dollar spot pathogen is reduced, which delays the development of an epidemic until mid-summer when dollar spot naturally goes dormant due to high temperatures. Early-season applications of Tourney[®] Fungicide also clean up lingering basal stem anthracnose infections.

FOR AN EARLY-SEASON DOLLAR SPOT PROGRAM, APPLY TOURNEY:

- Using the rate of 0.28 - 0.37 oz/1,000 sq ft
- With 2 gal water/1,000 sq ft
- At 170 accumulated growing degree days, base 50

SPRING BROAD SPECTRUM SPRAY

A strategically timed application of Tourney will control up to six key tough diseases, including fairy ring, summer patch, basal stem anthracnose, necrotic ring spot, take-all patch and brown ring patch. Tourney is xylem-mobile; so, a high volume spray targeting soil-borne diseases also protects against foliar diseases such as dollar spot and anthracnose.

FOR CONTROL OF THESE KEY DISEASES, APPLY TOURNEY:

- At 0.37 oz/1,000 sq ft
- When soil temperatures consistently reach 65 - 68°F (at a depth of 3")
- Using a high volume of water (>2 gal/1,000 sq ft) or water-in
- Re-apply after 28 days if diseases are well established or if weather conditions warrant

FALL CLEAN-UP SPRAY

The end of the season is time to start preparing for the following season. Tourney, applied as the clean-up spray in the fall, will help clean up lingering tough disease infections and reduce disease potential the following spring.
