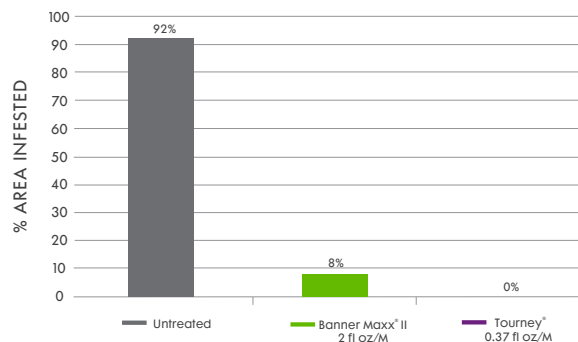

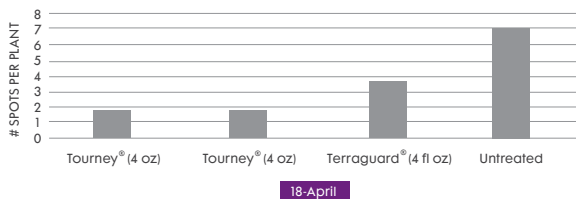

ANTHRACNOSE CONTROL ON HYDRANGEA

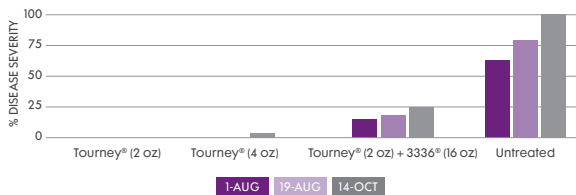
Anthracnose can attack both the leaves and the blooms of bigleaf hydrangea. Hot, wet weather favors disease development; and heavily fertilized plants seem to be more susceptible.



A Chase, Chase Horticulture Research, Mt. Auburn, CA. Treatments applied on a seven day interval, beginning 28 March. Plants were inoculated 1 April with *Colletotrichum gloeosporioides*. Rates are ounces per 100 gallons of water.

LILAC POWDERY MILDEW CONTROL

Tourney EZ performs well even in high disease severity situations. The chart below demonstrates how Tourney delivers outstanding powdery mildew control for plants like lilac either solo or combined with another fungicide.



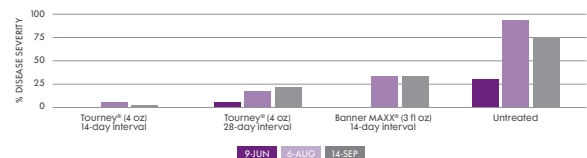

USE SUMMARY - ORNAMENTALS

DISEASES CONTROLLED	RATE (OZ/100 GALS WATER)
Anthracnose	2 to 4 fl oz on a 14-to-28-day interval.
Botrytis	
Blossom Rot/Brown Rot	Apply as a foliar spray when targeting foliar diseases or as a drench when targeting crown and/or root diseases.
Conifer Blight	
Damping	100 gallons of spray mix will treat 20,000 sq ft of area when using a typical high-volume sprayer. If using a low volume sprayer, adjust concentration to apply the same amount of product per unit area.

APPLE SCAB CONTROL CRABAPPLE (MALUS SP.) TREES

Apple scab can be an especially tough disease and Tourney EZ delivers best-in-class control even on 28-day spray intervals. The chart below demonstrates the superior apple scab control of Tourney vs. the industry standard.
