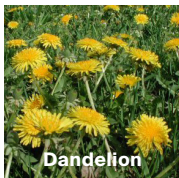

QUINCLORAC 2, 4-D TRICLOPYR SULFENTRAZONE



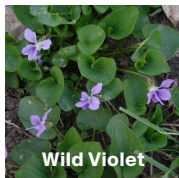

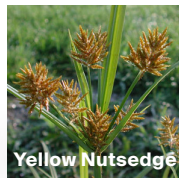

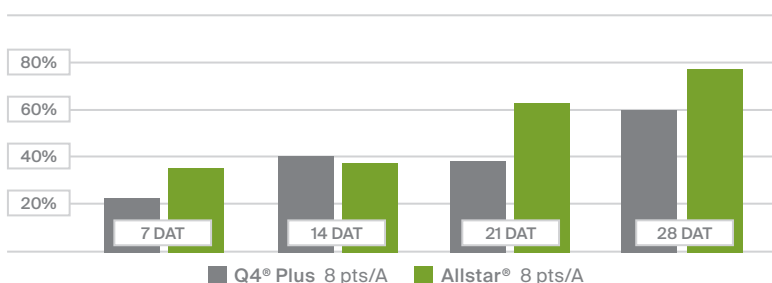

	RATE
COOL-SEASON TURF Bluegrass (annual, common, Kentucky, rough), ryegrass (annual, perennial), Fescue (fine, tall) Use reduced rates if grass is stressed from heat or drought. Only apply to fine fescue when it is part of a blend.	7-8 pints/A
WARM-SEASON TURF Bermudagrass (common, hybrid), zoysiagrass Yellowing may occur on Bermudagrass, this can be reduced by the addition of chelated iron or sprayable soluble nitrogen.	5-7 pints/A
BENTGRASS Creeping bentgrass Applications to established creeping bentgrass must be applied in 2 to 3 split applications at 3-5 pts/A.	3-5 pints/A
