Chocolate spot & rust

Two-spray programmes are normally required to control chocolate spot and rust, unless very aggressive chocolate spot or downy mildew have necessitated an additional treatment pre-flowering.

- Optimum time to commence fungicide programmes for protection against chocolate spot and rust is from early flowering, when the first signs of chocolate spot start to appear.
- Follow up with mid-late flowering sprays (3 weeks after the previous application) to top-up and protect previously untreated new growth.

Pay attention to pre-harvest intervals when selecting products for use later in season.

Fungicide activity at a glance...

TAZER

Good protectant control of rust and chocolate spot. Also has some activity against Ascochyta.

- Max individual dose 1.0 l/ha
- Max 2 applications per crop.
- Latest application 35 days before harvest.
- Aquatic buffer zone: Crop 5m

tebuconazole

Good control of chocolate spot and rust. Keep application rates up, especially if disease develops quickly.

- *Refer to product label for details of max application rates, pre-harvest intervals and aquatic buffer zone requirements.*
